The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the act of murder against, HOWARD STEINDLER, in the City of Los Angeles. On March 9, 1977, at approximately 7:05 p.m., Howard Steindler, age 77, was in an altercation with two male suspects near his residence on Killion Street near Lindley Avenue. Shortly thereafter, at 8:00 p.m., Mr. Steindler was found dead in the rear of his vehicle, which was parked on the eastbound Ventura Freeway. Mr. Steindler was missing his wallet and jewelry when he was found. At the time of his death, Mr. Steindler was a prominent boxing manager and promoter, and he owned the Main Street Gym in downtown Los Angeles. Since police detectives have been unable to identify any suspects, they hope that a monetary reward may rekindle interest in the case and motivate witnesses to come forward. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, JANUARY 5, 2016. La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Consejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma de hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por la muerte de HOWARD STEINDLER, en la Ciudad de Los Angeles.
