Subject: RESOLUTION 26-10697: SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 999 WITH CHINA SHIPPING HOLDING COMPANY, LTD.

Pursuant to Section 606 of the Los Angeles City Charter, enclosed for your approval is POLA Resolution No. 26-10697, specific to the Seventh Amendment to Permit No. 999 with China Shipping Holding Company, LTD., which would 1) incorporate into a legally binding permit amendment all additional or revised mitigation measures and/or lease measures added as a result of the certified 2025 Final Revised Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (RSEIR) and the 2019 Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) for the Berths 97-109 China Shipping Container Terminal Project (Project), which measures will be concurrently approved by the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) in a related companion item; 2) establish commercial terms concerning the payments related to the revised Greenhouse Gas (GHG) mitigation measure; and 3) modify the notice requirements for China Shipping to exercise its three successive options to extend Permit 999. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action has been previously evaluated pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II Section 2(i) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines, and that further CEQA compliance will be required in the pending trial court remedy as discussed within the resolution;
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 26-10697 for the Seventh Amendment to Permit 999 with China Shipping Holding Company, LTD.
