MOTION

The Burbank Boulevard – Lankershim Boulevard to Cleon Avenue Project was funded through the 2001 Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) Call for Projects and the Letter of Agreement was executed with the Metro in January 2008. This project will widen approximately 0.7 miles of Burbank Boulevard by 12 feet on both sides between Lankershim Boulevard and Cleon Avenue to Major Highway Standards. The widening will provide two traffic lanes, a parking lane and a bike lane in each direction, including a center turn lane.

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is interested in recharging the San Fernando Groundwater Basin to reduce the City’s dependence on imported water and is providing \$1,000,000 to install 16 drywells within the project’s 0.7-mile limits. The drywells would divert, percolate and recharge approximately 53 acre-feet of stormwater runoff annually. Construction is expected to be completed by June 30, 2018. Action is needed to accept the \$1.0M from LADWP and cause the funds to be deposited appropriately.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the LADWP to accept the amount of \$1,000,000 to implement Green Street Elements (GSE) in the Burbank Boulevard – Lankershim Boulevard to Cleon Avenue Project, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE to authorize the Director of Accounting to deposit these LADWP GSE funds into a new account in the Bureau of Engineering Special Services Fund No. 682-50 entitled “Burbank Boulevard –Lankershim Boulevard to Cleon Avenue Project – Green Street Elements.”

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
