

SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF THE REPORT OF A NO COST EXTENSION FOR THE
2007 ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the report concurrently to the Mayor and City Council.
3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
 - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to ACCEPT the California Emergency Management Agency's approval of a no cost extension for the 2007 Anti-Gang Initiative Grant, extending the award period from June 30, 2009 to December 31, 2009;
 - B. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer to include the Crime and Intelligence Analyst II position in the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Personnel Authority Resolution for Fiscal Year 2009-10; and,
 - C. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

DISCUSSION

The 2007 Anti-Gang Initiative (AGI) grant program provides funding for one Crime and Intelligence Analyst (CIA) position assigned to the Gang and Narcotics Division. The extension will allow the Department to fully expend grant funds. The CIA works in conjunction with the Joint Regional Intelligence Center (JRIC), Los Angeles Regional Gang Information Network (LARGIN), local, state and transnational police gang-intelligence agencies. The collaboration allows the CIA the ability to work closely with specialized entities and divisional gang units throughout the Department to expedite gang-related intelligence. The CIA assists in forecasting future occurrences in crime series and to identify and disseminate crucial information so that the LAPD can develop long-term policies, strategies and problem-solving solutions to address the problem.

The LAPD will continue to work closely with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, INTERPOL, the Office of the City Attorney, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, the Los Angeles County Department of Probation, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the United States Attorney's Office for the Central District of California. This collaboration continues under the AGI program with the understanding that case filings would be processed by the prosecutorial entity anticipated to garner the harshest sentence for suspects.



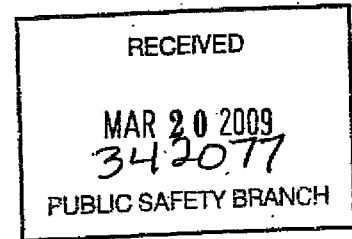
