**Minutes  
Executive Committee Meeting  
September 10, 2012  
12:00 pm**

Attendance: Anthony J. Braswell, President; Ginny Hatfield, V. President, Dorothy Apple, Secretary; Jeff Walker (non-member), NCVV Board and Chair City Services Committee

The meeting was called to order by Tony Braswell. The Executive Committee was provided an overview of the proposed amendment to the City of Los Angeles Above Ground Facility (AGF) ordinance.

The amendment to the AGF ordinance will be presented to the City Council on Tuesday, September 11. The amendment was forwarded by the Public Works and PLUM Committees.

NCVV has heard from numerous stakeholders over the past several years, registering complaints about AGFs that have proliferated exponentially around Valley Village. Most recently a long time resident, Alice Hart, was involved in a year long battle with AT&T about an AGF that would be located directly across from her home on Magnolia Boulevard. NCVV support the effort to relocate the AGF. Mr. Walker's committee has been involved in this issue for some time.

The Executive Committee voted 3-0 to support a proposal from the Sunland-Tujunga NC to lend support for the proposed amendments. The Executive Committee also supports additional action that would require :

- Elimination of the utility pole exemption
- Expansion of the notice of provisions
- Enhancement of the aesthetic provisions
- Imposition of permit duration limits.

Further, the Executive Committee of NCVV requests enactment of an Interim Control Ordinance that would impose a temporary moratorium for a specific period of time on the applications for permits and installation of wireless facilities in the public right of way while the Ordinance amendments are being drafted.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:20 pm.
