ORDINANCE NO. 181214

An ordinance amending Section 80.81 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to change the speed limit on Sheldon Street in the City of Los Angeles.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subdivision S of Subsection (2) of Section 80.81 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by deleting the following:

Sheldon Street between Glenoaks Boulevard and Roscoe Boulevard.

Sec 2. Subdivision S of Subsection (3) of Section 80.81 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended by adding the following in alphabetical order:

Sheldon Street between Glenoaks Boulevard and Roscoe Boulevard.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.





Your TRANSPORTATION Committee

reports as follows:

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE relative to increasing the speed limit from 35 to 40 miles per hour along Sheldon Street between Glenoaks and Roscoe Boulevards.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. CONCUR with the Board of Transportation Commissioners action of August 13, 2009, increasing the speed limit from 35 to 40 miles per hour along Sheldon Street between Glenoaks and Roscoe Boulevards.
2. PRESENT and ADOPT accompanying ORDINANCE amending Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.81 to establish the recommended speed limit of Recommendation No. 1.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Transportation Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Transportation Commissioners dated August 13, 2010, the Department of Transportation (DOT) recommends increasing the speed limit from 35 to 40 miles per hour along Sheldon Street between Glenoaks and Roscoe Boulevards. In order for jurisdictions to legally use radar enforcement, the California Vehicle Code requires that speed limits be established using factual and impartial criteria. These factors include prevailing critical speeds, collision history, and the existence of any conditions not readily apparent to motorists. DOT completed an engineering and traffic survey on Sheldon Street between Glenoaks and Roscoe Boulevards and found that a speed limit of 40 miles per hour is consistent with traffic conditions and roadway characteristics and will facilitate the safe and orderly movement of traffic. On August 13, 2010, the Board of Transportation Commissioners approved DOT's recommendation.

At its meeting held June 9, 2010, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the above recommendations to increase the speed limit from 35 to 40 miles per hour along Sheldon Street between Glenoaks and Roscoe Boulevards, as recommended by the Board of Transportation Commissioners.
