SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF THE EXTENSION FOR THE 2009 LOS ANGELES SMART POLICING PROJECT

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the report concurrently to the Mayor and City Council.
3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
 - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or designee to ACCEPT the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) no cost extension for the 2009 Los Angeles Smart Policing Project, extending the award period from August 31, 2012 to February 28, 2013;
 - B. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or designee, to execute the Third Amendment to Contract No. C-118498, between the City of Los Angeles and Justice and Security Strategies, Inc., extending the term of the agreement from August 31, 2012 to February 28, 2013, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and legality;
 - C. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer appropriations within Fund 339 from 2009 Los Angeles Smart Policing Appropriation Account Number F550 to the following accounts for LAPD civilian salaries \$19,505.00 and fringe benefits \$7,216.45;

Account 70J299	\$ 7,216.45
 - D. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to prepare Controller Instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

DISCUSSION

In October 2009, the USDOJ, OJP, BJA awarded the LAPD \$499,959 for the 2009 Los Angeles Smart Policing Project. The purpose of the Smart Policing Initiative is to enhance its data-driven, evidence-based approach to crime control.

The LAPD requested a no-cost extension in order to implement, expand and complete the evaluation of the Los Angeles Strategic Extraction and Restoration (LASER) Program. Operation LASER emphasizes location-based and offender-based strategies. These strategies led to crime reduction (homicides and gun-related crimes) in Newton Division over a ten-month period. By testing these concepts in two additional Divisions, the LAPD believes that it can sustain the Smart Policing Initiative throughout the City.

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**THIRD AMENDMENT TO CITY CONTRACT NO. C-118498
BETWEEN
THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
AND
JUSTICE AND SECURITY STRATEGIES, INC.**

This **THIRD AMENDMENT** ("Third Amendment") to Los Angeles City Contract No. C-118498 is made and entered into by and between the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Police Department ("LAPD"), and Justice and Security Strategies, Inc., a Virginia corporation ("Subrecipient").

WHEREAS, the City and the Subrecipient have entered into Los Angeles City Contract No. C-118498 (the "Agreement") wherein Subrecipient agreed to act as the City's research partner to develop problem solving techniques using computer analytic tools to increase police officer/investigator efficiency in reducing the incidence of gun violence in specific neighborhoods in Los Angeles and the City agreed to pay Subrecipient for such services using grant funds from the Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 Los Angeles Smart Policing: Evidence-Based Law Enforcement: Smart Policing Demonstration Initiative Grant Program (the "Grant"), said Agreement having a term from May 1, 2010 to February 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section 602 of the Agreement provides for amendments to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Subrecipient are desirous of amending the Agreement to extend the Agreement without changing the scope of services or the total compensation paid under the Agreement pursuant to authorization provided by Section 14.8 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, this Third Amendment is necessary and proper to continue and/or complete certain activities authorized under the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the Subrecipient hereby agree that the Agreement be amended as follows:

1. Section 102.A.1 shall be amended to replace Captain Rick Wall with Captain Sean Malinowski.
2. Section 201, Time of Performance:
The term of this Agreement shall commence on May 1, 2010 and end February 28, 2013, and any additional period of time as is required to complete any necessary close-out activities. Said term is subject to the provisions herein. Performance shall not commence until the Subrecipient has obtained the City's approval of the insurance required in Section 413 herein.

3. Except as herein amended or modified, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
4. This Third Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. This Third Amendment includes two (2) pages which constitute the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the City and the Subrecipient have caused this Third Amendment to be executed by their respective duly authorized representatives.
