MOTION

On March 5, 2002, under Council File No. 01-1459, the City Council adopted new procedures for processing street vacations, which require the adoption of a Rule 16 motion to initiate street vacation proceedings at the request and instance of an application from the petitioner. Under these new procedures, when a petitioner submits an application and a fee deposit to the Bureau of Engineering, the Chair of the Public Works Committee is required to introduce a motion for the purpose of initiating the investigation of the vacation.

The City Council on February 23, 2011, under Council File No. 10-0224, conditionally approved the vacation of the alley southwesterly of La Loma Road from 233 feet southeasterly of Genevieve Avenue to its southeasterly terminus. The vacation conditions were not complied with prior to the expiration of the vacation approval.

Vons Companies Inc., owner of the properties legally described as Lots 6 through 13, of Tract No. 5618; and Lots A, Arb 2, B and C, of Tract No. 483; has submitted a new application requesting to vacate the same street, located in Council District 14.

Additionally, the adoption of the following recommendations does not constitute or imply approval of the vacation.

I THEREFORE MOVE that upon adoption of this motion, alley vacation proceedings be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed to process this vacation request under Council File No. 10-0224, Engineering work order No. E1401152.

I FURTHER REQUEST that the City Clerk append this Motion to Council File No. 10-0224.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Works Committee.

I FURTHER MOVE that upon review of the Public Works Committee, the City Clerk be directed to schedule this request for the City Council's consideration at the appropriate time under the City's Street Vacation procedures.
