This Office recommends that discussions with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding this pending litigation and significant exposure to litigation be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Sections 54956.9(d)(1), (d)(2), and (e)(2) (numerous potential cases). Government Code Section 54956.9 requires you to state publicly prior to the closed session what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation and regarding a significant exposure to litigation regarding facts and circumstances that are known to a potential plaintiff or plaintiffs, that might result in litigation against the City, and which facts or circumstances shall be publicly stated on the agenda or announced.


This matter arises out of the Americans with Disabilities Act sidewalk repair settlement regarding the City's public right-of-way.
