Subject: Renaming of Community area as Sherwood Forest – CF 11-0645

The Bureau of Engineering has reviewed the application submitted to change the community name of a neighborhood in the north central San Fernando Valley that is currently considered to be part of the Northridge community. The application proposes renaming the neighborhood as Sherwood Forest.

There are approximately 1,200 properties with an estimated population from the 2010 census of 4848 people. This community is entirely within zipcode 91325 and solely within Council District 12. The community plan area is Northridge, there appears to be no certified Neighbor Council for this community and this area is generally considered part of Northridge.

The attached maps shows the parcels in the area that are proposed to be included in the new community as shown on the application and shows the boundaries of the council districts, community plans, and historical community boundaries.





The Bureau of Engineering has no additional pertinent information concerning the historical use of this name for this neighborhood in the community.

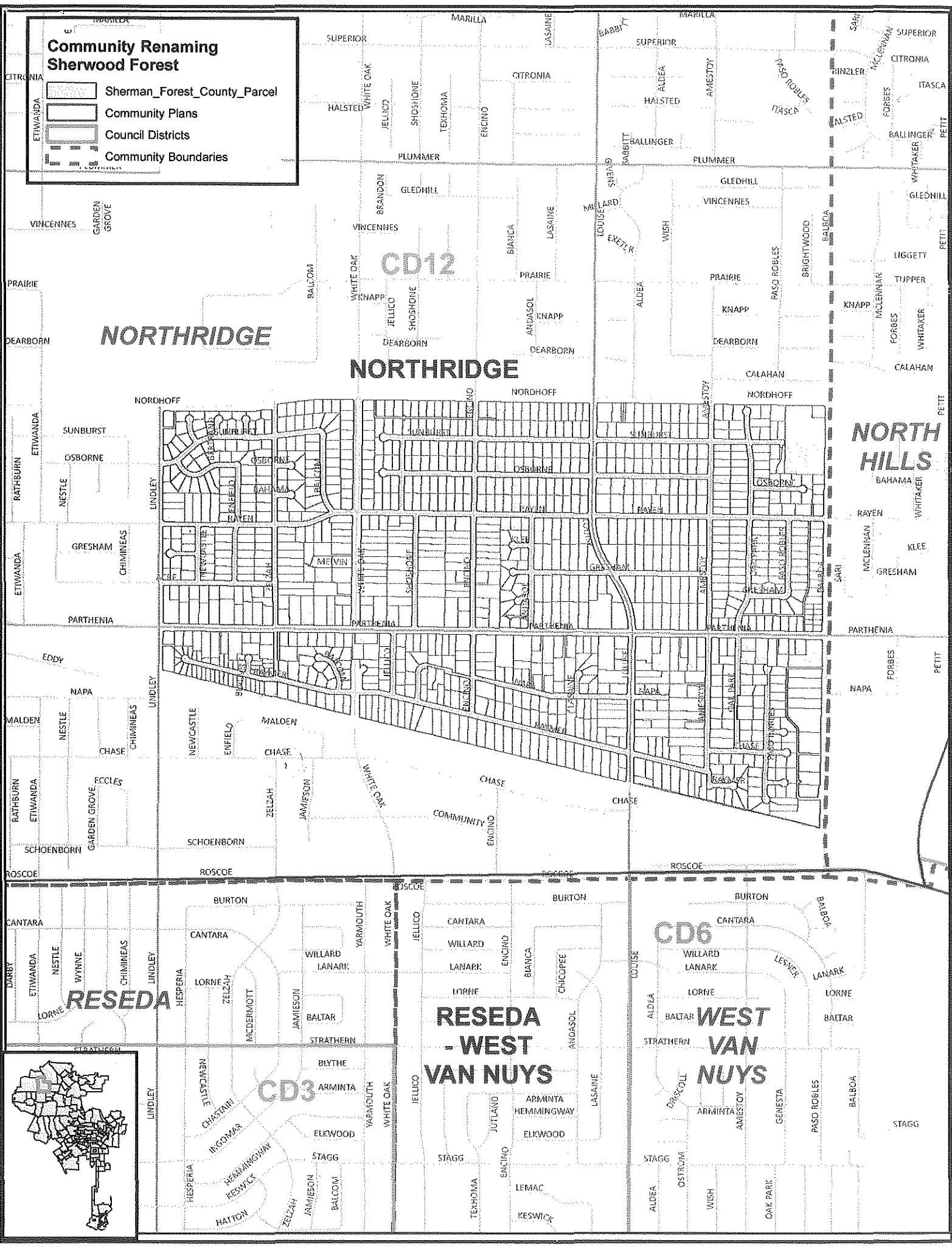

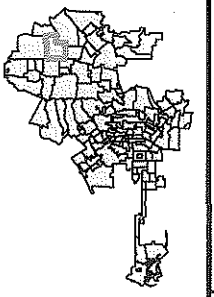
