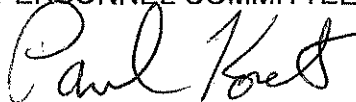

Summary:

At its June 1, 2011 meeting, your Committee considered a communication from the Mayor dated May 18, 2011 relative to the LACC's request for Civil Service exemption for one position of Senior Sales Representative I and one Senior Sales Representative II. The Mayor's communication, attached to the Council file, states that the Senior Sales Representative (SSR) I is responsible for sales and promotion of LACC facilities and business services. In addition to performing the duties of the SSR I, the SSR II assists the Marketing Manager with the training of junior level staff and administration of Marketing Division policies and procedures. Requirements for the positions include knowledge of the convention center market and excellent track records in performing sales related to event services for convention centers or major hotels. After offering the opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approval of the exemption request as reflected above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
