The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the death of, ANDRES ORDONEZ, in the City of Los Angeles. On Sunday, November 4, 2012, at approximately 6:20 p.m., 25-year old Andres Ordonez was fatally shot, and another individual was wounded, when they attempted to stop an individual from spray painting a church they attended, located in the 3000 block of West Beverly Boulevard. Both victims approached the suspect, described as a Hispanic female, and attempted to stop her from vandalizing the church. During the exchange, a second suspect exited a stopped vehicle and opened fire, hitting both victims. Detectives are continuing to investigate the shooting but have not identified the suspects at this time. Detectives hope that a monetary reward compels members of the public to provide more information. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, FEBRUARY 27, 2017. The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. El domingo 4 de noviembre de 2012, aproximadamente a las 6:20 p.m., Andrés Ordoñez de 25 años de edad, fue baleado fatalmente, y otro individuo resultó herido, cuando intentaron detener a un individuo de pintura de aerosol una iglesia a la que asistían, ubicada en el 3000 de la cuadra de West Beverly Boulevard. Ambas víctimas se acercaron al sospechoso, descrita como una mujer hispana, e intentaron detenerla de vandalizar la iglesia. Durante el intercambio, un segundo sospechoso salió de un vehículo y abrió fuego, alcanzando ambas víctimas. Los detectives continúan investigando el tiroteo, pero no ha identificado a los sospechosos en este momento. Los detectives esperan que una recompensa monetaria oblige a los miembros del público a proporcionar más información. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Concejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de recompensa terminará, y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 27 DE FEBRERO DE 2017.
