The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit related projects, sidewalk projects, curb / sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto, as well as on general services to the community in each Council District.

The Korean Chamber of Commerce of Los Angeles is coordinating various security services for the transit public near a transit hub in Council District 10.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD-10 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Council District 10 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund which could allocated for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$36,000 in the Council District 10 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D Dept. 50 be allocated to the Korean Chamber of Commerce of Los Angeles for various security services for the transit public near a transit hub in Council District 10.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to prepare the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to the Korean Chamber of Commerce of Los Angeles, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, from the above source, and for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed; and that the Council member of the District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that Bureau of Street Services be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarification as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
