

MOTION

I MOVE that the Arts, Parks, Health and Aging Committee report relative to the installation of equine traffic control devices, related funding mechanisms, and equestrian improvements (C.F. 12-0307-S5), No. 1 on today's agenda, BE AMENDED to reflect the following new Recommendations 1 and 2 in lieu of Recommendations 1 and 2 contained in the report:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation to accept the donation of \$50,000 by Melanie Coto to be used for horse trail and equestrian-related improvements and to deposit these funds into Fund No. 100-94 Acct. 3360 Signal Supplies and to thank the donor.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the transfer of \$59,000 from the Council District Seven portion of the Council Fund No. 100-28, Account No. 1010, to be used for horse trail and equestrian-related improvements, to Fund 100-94 in the following amounts:
