THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS

DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1, Section 137, of Ordinance

Section 1. Section 137 of Ordinance 187,712 shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

OPERATIVE DATE. The operative date for this ordinance shall be January 22,

Sec. 2. **URGENCY**. The City finds that inconsistency in the application of the development regulations throughout the City and interruption in the implementation of the City's coastal development permit program, consistent with the requirements of the California Coastal Act, will be injurious to the health, safety, and general welfare of the City. Any lapse in the administration of permits for development projects within the coastal zone creates uncertainty in terms of public health and economic development and immediate economic development, and immediate economic development, and immediate action is necessary to ensure no loss in permitting authority. The immediate enactment of these provisions will minimize loss of employment, closure of businesses, loss of redevelopment potential, curtailment of City revenues and subsequent curtailment or vital services, and will prevent reactive, impacts to and will prevent negative impacts to quality of life, health, safety, and public welfare. For all of these reasons, this ordinance shall become effective upon

welfare. For all of these reasons, this ordinance shall become effective upon publication pursuant to Section 253 of the Los Angeles City Charter. Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
