

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Foreclosure Registry Program to provide for exemptions from its requirements for governmental entities and natural persons, to establish a formal appeals process, and to make other technical changes.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying Ordinance, dated February 16, 2022, amending the Foreclosure Registry Program, Article 4 of Chapter XVI of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), to provide for exemptions from its requirements for governmental entities and natural persons, to establish a formal appeals process, and to make other technical changes.

At a regular meeting held on August 24, 2022, the Housing Committee considered a City Attorney report and draft Ordinance relative to amending the Foreclosure Registry Program, Article 4 of Chapter XVI of LAMC, to provide for exemptions from its requirements for governmental entities and natural persons, to establish a formal appeals process, and to make other technical changes.
