Summary:

On April 16, 2013, you Committee considered a March 14, 2013 communication from the Mayor relative to the Civil Service exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator and Four Project Coordinators for the LAHD pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b). The report, as attached to the Council file, provides details on said re-exemption request. According to the CLA, on February 6, 2013 Council took an action to exempt the positions from Civil Service provisions in connection with Council File No. 12-0049 and as such, the Mayor's request will finalize this process.
