PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a review of the existing street standards involving street dedications, street improvements, street lights, and street trees for the community surrounding the University of Southern (USC) California Health Sciences Campus, including Los Angeles County USC Medical Center.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Huizar – Reyes):

1. AUTHORIZE the processing of B-permits.
2. INSTRUCT the Planning Department, Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Department of Recreation and Parks, and the Bureaus of Engineering, Street Services, and Street Lighting to report back to the Planning and Land Use Management Committee on December 4, 2012 with a status report regarding the review of existing street standards involving street dedications, street improvements, street lights, and street trees for the community surrounding the USC California Health Sciences Campus, including Los Angeles County USC Medical Center, for conditions that are no longer relevant within the proposed street beautification project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis on this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At the public hearing held on September 25, 2012 (continued from the September 11, 2012 meeting), the Planning and Land Use Management Committee considered Motion (Huizar – Reyes) relative to a review of the existing street standards involving street dedications, street improvements, street lights, and street trees for the community surrounding the USC California Health Sciences Campus, including Los Angeles County USC Medical Center. Staff from the Planning Department and the Bureau of Engineering gave the Committee background information on the matter. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended the authorization of the processing of B-permits and instructed the departments to return to PLUM Committee on December 4, 2012 with status reports on this item. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
