HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to evaluating the property located at 1905 N. Highland Avenue, which may be suitable for development as 100% affordable housing or permanent supportive housing; and, issue a Request for Proposals.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (RAMAN – RIDLEY-THOMAS):

- 1. DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the General Services Department, the Bureau of Engineering, the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA), and any other relevant departments, to initiate a review of the Cityowned property located at 1905 N. Highland Avenue in Council District 4 to determine the suitability of the property for development as 100% affordable housing and/or permanent supportive housing, in conformance with the procedure set forth for the City's Asset Evaluation Framework, and to report back to the City Council within 45 days.
- AUTHORIZE, if the property is suitable for development as described herein, the CAO, in conjunction with the General Manager, HCIDLA, or designee, to add the City-owned property located at 1905 N. Highland Avenue to the list of City-owned parcels that will be made available to qualified developers through a Request for Proposal.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
