Comments for Public Posting: For the last year our small street has been under siege from a newly built 'professional' party house (advertising on Instagram) with headliner DJs. Hundreds of people descend on our neighborhood of nine modest houses multiple times a month, parking illegally, blocking the street, and leaving garbage, condoms, and tampons in the gutters. Not to mention urinating on neighbors' lawns. LAPD is understaffed and not always able to respond.
