On Sunday, December 2, 2012, at approximately 2:15 a.m., a 22-year old male was struck by a vehicle while crossing Reseda Boulevard at Bessemer Street. While the victim lay motionless in the roadway, a second vehicle struck him. Tragically, the pedestrian died of his injuries. The first vehicle is described as a 1997/1998 dark grey SUV with a possible 4"-5" lift kit, and the second as a compact passenger car. Both drivers fled the scene and officials are looking for any possible leads. A monetary reward may be vital to identifying the suspects responsible. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, AUGUST 11, 2015.

El domingo 2 de diciembre de 2012, aproximadamente a las 2:15 a.m., un hombre de 22 años de edad fue golpeado por un vehículo mientras cruzaba Reseda Boulevard en Bessemer Street.
