 The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for a FATAL HIT-AND-RUN, in the City of Los Angeles. On Sunday, December 2, 2012, at approximately 2:12 a.m., a 22-year old male was struck by a vehicle while crossing Reseda Boulevard at Bessemer Street. While the victim lay motionless in the roadway, a second vehicle struck him. Tragically, the pedestrian died of his injuries. The first vehicle is described as a 1997/1998 dark grey SUV with a possible 4'-6" lift kit, and the second as a compact passenger car. Both drivers fled the scene and officials are looking for any possible leads. A monetary reward may be vital to identifying the suspects responsible. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, AUGUST 15, 2013.  
 The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 160866. 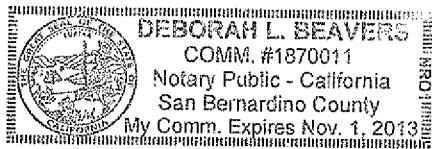

**AVISO DE RECOMPENSA DE \$50,000**

La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Consejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma o hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por proveer información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por GOLPEAR Y CAERSE A LA RUGA MORTAL en la Ciudad de Los Angeles. El domingo 2 de diciembre de 2012, aproximadamente a las 2:15 a.m., un hombre de 22 años de edad fue arrojado por un vehículo mientras cruzaba Reseda Boulevard en Bessemer Street. Mientras la víctima yacía inmóvil en la carretera un segundo vehículo lo golpeó. Trágicamente, el peatón murió de sus heridas. El primer vehículo es descrito como una SUV, gris oscuro, 1997/1998 con un kit de elevación de 4'5", y el segundo como un carro de pasajeros compacto. Ambos conductores huyeron de la escena y los oficiales están buscando alguna posible pista. Una recompensa monetaria puede ser vital para la identificación de los presuntos responsables. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Consejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de recompensa terminará y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 15 DE AGOSTO DE 2013.
