SUBJECT:

Initiation of Vacation Proceedings - Alley Easterly of Main Street from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to approximately 230 feet Northerly Thereof - VAC - E1401205

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. That upon adoption of this report, the vacation proceeding to vacate alley easterly of Main Street from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to approximately 230 feet northerly thereof as shown on Exhibit B, be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.
- B. That the Bureau of Engineering be directed to process this vacation request under Council File No. 13-0031, Engineering Work Order No. E1401205.
- C. That the Bureau of Engineering be directed to investigate the feasibility of this vacation request.
- D. That the Bureau of Engineering present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee.
- E. That upon consideration and approval by the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee, the City Clerk be directed to coordinate with the Chair, subject to the concurrence of the Council President and schedule this request for the City Council's consideration at the appropriate time consistent

with the public hearing requirement under California Street and Highways Code Section 8320.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

A fee of \$26,344.25 was paid by the petitioner for the investigation of this request pursuant to Section 7.42 of the Administrative Code. Any deficit fee to recover the cost pursuant to Section 7.44 of the Administrative Code will be required of the petitioner.


