DISCUSSION

The donation will benefit the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) by distributing resources to specialized units throughout the City of Los Angeles (City). The X-26 TASER is one of many force options deployed by the Department. Supplying officers in the field with force options, such as the X-26 TASER, would assist them in carrying out their mission to protect and serve the community. Additionally, the Chief of Police recently mandated that the data captured on Electronic Control Devices be downloaded as a permanent record of the use of force. The 48 X-26 Dataport Download Kits will assist with Department personnel with meeting the aforementioned mandate.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.

SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ACCEPT DONATION

It is requested that Administrative Services Bureau approve and forward correspondence to the Board of Police Commissioners to accept the unsolicited donation of 30 X-26 TASER Electronic Control Devices and 48 X26 Dataport Kits valued at \$33,452.76 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation. The donation was offered on September 18, 2012.

The X-26 TASER is one of many force options deployed by the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). Currently, the Department has 1,275 TASERs for more than 9,000 sworn employees who have been trained and certified to deploy the device. Therefore, not every officer has access to a TASER. The additional X-26 TASERs would assist the Department in spreading resources to specialized units throughout the City of Los Angeles. Supplying our officers in the field with force options, such as the X-26 TASERs, will assist them in carrying out their mission of protecting and serving our communities. Additionally, the Chief of Police recently mandated that the data captured on Electronic Control Devices be downloaded as a permanent record of the use of force. The 48 X26 Dataport Download Kits will assist with Department personnel with meeting the aforementioned mandate.
