The donation will give Southeast Area the ability to implement a DART unit in partnership with Project PeaceMakers Incorporated. The deployment of a DART unit in Southeast Area will provide early intervention services that will assist domestic violence (DV) victims, including children, in obtaining aid and resources. The training provided to the DART officers will afford them specialized knowledge to improve their ability to focus on the uniqueness of DV investigations, resulting in more appropriate methods of counseling and more thorough and complete investigative reports. It is also anticipated that the program will enable better allocation of resources by freeing up deployed units to handle non-domestic violence calls for service.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.


