Honorable Members:

As requested by the City Council on August 4, 2015, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration, approved as to form and legality, the enclosed revised draft ordinance amending Subsection (c) of Section 46.30 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to add new Subdivisions 14 and 15. These new subdivisions will exempt retired peace officers and qualified reserve peace officers from the ban on possessing large-capacity magazines. Additional language was added to clarify the exemption in Subdivision (1).
