PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to exempting retired peace officers and qualified reserve officers from the ban on possessing large-capacity magazines.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending Subsection (c) of Section 46.30 to Los Angeles Municipal Code to clarify the language of the exemption in Subdivision 1 and to add new Subdivisions 14 and 15 to exempt retired peace officers and qualified reserve officers from the ban on possessing large-capacity magazines, as amended to change the reference of Penal Code Section 836.6 to Penal Code Section 830.6 into Section 46.30 (c)15 of the Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on October 20, 2015, your Public Safety Committee considered a City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to exempt retired peace officers and qualified reserve officers from the ban on possessing large-capacity magazines. An opportunity for public comment was provided. During the discussion of the matter, the Committee Chair requested that the Ordinance be amended to change the reference of Penal Code Section 836.6 to Penal Code Section 830.6 into Section 46.30 (c)15 of the Ordinance. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee moved to approve the Ordinance submitted by the City Attorney as amended, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
