
Located in Downtown Los Angeles, San Julian Park provides services to Skid Row's homeless community. For the past several years, these services were provided by SRO Housing Corporation, a non-profit, community-based organization. On July 1, 2015, the City's Recreation and Parks Department will take over operation of the park. Due to a budgetary oversight, the FY 14-15 funding provided to SRO was \$16,000 short. Therefore, to cover this gap, the City Council should authorize the granting of \$16,000 in Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) funds to SRO.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council authorize the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD) to transfer \$16,000 in Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) funds to the Housing and Community Investment Department (HCID) for the purpose of funding SRO's operation of San Julian Park.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council authorize HCID to negotiate and execute a contract with SRO for \$16,000 in UDAG funds for the purpose of funding SRO's operation of San Julian Park.

I FURTHER MOVE that EWDD, with the assistance of HCID, be directed to prepare Controller's instructions and/or technical changes to effectuate the above transfer, subject to the approval of the Chief Legislative Analyst, and authorize the Controller to implement said instructions.
