

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authorizing the Bureau of Engineering to receive funding for the design of a four-inch water line that will run under the Spring Street Bridge.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo – O'Farrell), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Engineering to:

- a. Receive \$50,000 from Metabolic Studio, deposit said funds to Engineering Special Service Fund No. 682/50, and appropriate therein to Spring Street Bridge - Metabolic Studio Account No. 50JVAJ for the design of a four-inch water line that will run under the Spring Street Bridge and allow connection to Metabolic Studio's WaterWheel Project and provide irrigation to Albion Park.
- b. Negotiate and execute a letter of agreement or similar instrument between the City and Metabolic Studio to implement the above work associated with the North Spring Street Viaduct Widening and Rehabilitation Project.
- c. Make any technical corrections or clarifications necessary to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On November 10, 2015, Council considered Motion (Cedillo – O'Farrell) relative to authorizing the Bureau of Engineering to receive funding for the design of a four-inch water line that will run under the Spring Street Bridge. Motion states that the Bureau of Engineering is undertaking the renovation of the North Spring Street Viaduct Widening and Rehabilitation Project. Metabolic Studio operates from a warehouse located under the western portion of the Spring Street Bridge. The proposed renovation of the bridge will unfortunately place bridge pier support walls between the warehouse and the open area under the bridge which has been maintained by Metabolic Studio for community art projects.

Motion movers go on to state that Metabolic Studio and the Bureau of Engineering have discussed constructing a four-inch water line that will run under the bridge to allow connection to the Studio's Water Wheel Project and provide irrigation to the adjacent Albion Park. Metabolic Studio has offered to pay for the full cost of the study, design, and construction of the water line. The estimated total cost of the design is \$50,000. Motion recommends that the Council authorize the Bureau to accept the fee from Metabolic. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held November 23, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion.
