COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE and ORDINANCE relative to approving a Purchase Power Agreement with Manzana Wind, LLC, to purchase up to 39 megawatts (MW) of renewable wind power capacity, electric energy, and environmental attributes.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE approving Purchase Power Agreement (PPA) No. BP 13-019 between the Department of Water and Power (DPW) and Manzana Wind, LLC, to purchase up to 39 MW of renewable wind power capacity, electric energy, and environmental attributes for a term of 10 years.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that the proposed PPA will have no direct impact on the City General Fund. Funds will be included in future Power Revenue Fund budget requests to provide up to \$86 million over the 10-year term of the PPA.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 19, 2013, the Chair of the Energy and Environment Committee considered reports from the Board of Water and Power Commissioners, CAO, and City Attorney, and Ordinance, relative to the approval of PPA No. BP 13-019 with Manzana Wind LLC for energy, environmental attributes, and capacity for the Manzana Wind Project to purchase 39 MW of electric energy, generating capacity, and environmental attributes from the Manzana Wind Project. The CAO reports that the source of the wind energy will be the Manzana Wind Project, a 189 MW wind facility consisting of 126 wind turbines located in Kern County, California, which commenced full commercial operation in December 2012. A separate short term PPA was approved by the DWP Board with Manzana which enables the Department to purchase 39 MW of wind energy for a limited two-year term from October 2012 through October 2014, or date of execution of this proposed PPA. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair moved to recommend approval of the recommendations as stated above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
