

On March 1, 2011 the Los Angeles City Council adopted the 2010 Bicycle Plan, which seeks to make bicycling a viable mode of active transportation to provide more opportunities to enjoy the overwhelming positive benefits of cycling, including congestion relief, improved air quality and better health. To that end the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) applied for, and has been awarded, a grant in the amount of \$17,000 from the Bikes Belong Foundation to fund public bicycle repair stations. No local match funds are required.

The Bikes Belong Foundation awarded the funds to various communities that are working to improve their bicycle programs, outreach and infrastructure. The Department's proposed Bicycle Repair Station Business Improvement Program will fund bicycle repair stations and permanent public air pumps in the public right-of-way at least seven locations throughout the City. Maintenance for the stations will be provided by a project sponsor who agrees to maintain the repair station.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation to:

- 1. Accept grant funds in the amount of \$17,000 and execute any necessary agreement with the Bikes Belong Foundation for the Bicycle Repair Station Business Improvement Program; and
- 2. Deposit the grant funds into the Department of Transportation Trust Fund No. 840/94, create a new \$17,000 appropriation account therein entitled "Bicycle Repair Station Bikes Belong" and expend the funds for the Bicycle Repair Station Business Improvement Program.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Controller be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above actions in order to effectuate the intent of this motion.
