

As part of the City Council confirmation process, you will need to meet with Joe Buscaino, your Councilmember, and Councilmember Tom LaBonge, the Chair of the Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee, to answer any questions they may have. You will be hearing from a City Council committee clerk who will let you know when your

reappointment will be considered by the Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee. Some time thereafter, you will be notified by the committee clerk when your reappointment will be presented to the full City Council for confirmation. Once you are confirmed, you will be required to take the oath of office in the City Clerk's Office in Room 395 of City Hall. Cary Gross will assist you during the confirmation process if you have questions.

Commissioners must be residents of the City of Los Angeles. If you move at any point during your term, have any changes in your telephone numbers, or in the future plan to resign (resignation must be put in writing), please contact my office immediately.
