

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to removing the 18-month sunset provision for recurring special events.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Bonin), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending Subsection (b) of Section 41.20 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to:

- a. Remove the 18-month sunset provision for recurring special events.
- b. Delete the paragraph that instructs the Bureau of Street Services to develop a How to Obtain a Special Event Permit Application informational brochure inasmuch as the Bureau already has implemented this provision.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## SUMMARY

On November 24, 2015, Council considered Motion (Englander - Bonin) relative to removing the 18-month sunset provision for recurring special events. Motion states that in July, 2014, Council approved Ordinance authorizing the Bureau of Street Services to issue an annual recurring Special Event Permit and designating certain streets in a Special Event Permit for the exclusive parking privilege of motor vehicles participating in the special event. By allowing a recurring special event to obtain an annual permit, better planning and coordination among the various City agencies, more efficient traffic control, easing the impacts of the event on surrounding residents and businesses were anticipated. Motion movers go on to state that special event permits have been issued over the past 18 months for recurring special events with great success. Therefore, a sunset provision is no longer necessary. Motion recommends that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance to delete the sunset provision. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

Accompanying a report to Council dated December 4, 2015, the City Attorney presents Ordinance amending Subsection (b) of Section 41.20 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to remove the 18-month sunset provision for recurring special events. The Ordinance also streamlines this section to delete the paragraph that instructs the Bureau of Street Services to develop a How to Obtain a Special Event Permit Application informational brochure as the Bureau already has implemented this provision.

At its special meeting held December 14, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve the accompanying Ordinance.
