The Greater Echo Park Elysian Neighborhood Council requests that the following Community Impact Statement be attached to Council File 13-1493: Street Vending.

On August 26, 2014, the Greater Echo Park Elysian Neighborhood Council (GEPENC) Board of Governors held a Brown Act compliant--noticed regular meeting with a quorum of 14; and with a vote of **14** yeas, **0** nays, and 1 abstention, the GEPENC adopted the motion in support of the City of Los Angeles to develop a comprehensive legal framework and an effective regulatory system regarding street vending that has the potential to protect health, increase public safety and economic activity, and with the possibility to permit and regulate food and non-food street vending on public right-of-ways and streets in the City of Los Angeles.
