

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of first aid/cardio pulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator training materials for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of first aid/cardio pulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator training materials, valued at \$98,583.34, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated January 10, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of first aid/cardio pulmonary resuscitation and automated external defibrillator training materials. LAPD reports that the training materials will enable all sworn field officers to achieve compliance with Peace Officer Standards and Training requirements and state law. The training provided will enable officers to render aid without having to rely on the Fire Department for use of its equipment. On January 21, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held February 14, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
