

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of fitness equipment for use by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Training Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of fitness equipment, valued at \$15,850, from 24 Hour Fitness USA, for use by the Department's Training Division at the Ahmanson Recruit Training Center, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated June 14, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of treadmills, spinning bikes, elliptical machines, barbell racks, and bench presses. The fitness equipment will be added to the existing fitness room at the Ahmanson Recruit Training Center to be used by recruit officers, along with Academy instructors and other Department personnel.

At its meeting held February 14, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
