



DISCUSSION

The Los Angeles Police Department's Harbor Area Community Relations Office will host the Young Women's Violence Prevention Conference. Violence against women continues to persist as one of the most heinous and prevalent issues in the world. The goal is to educate teenage females and reduce female involvement in gangs through gang intervention, prevention of sexual harassment, identifying, preventing, and reporting domestic violence, prevention of teenage pregnancy, non-submission to peer pressure, and anti-bullying education. The conference will be held annually for three years starting February 2014.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.


The grant will be used to fund the Los Angeles Police Department, Harbor Area "Young Women's Violence Prevention Conference." Violence against women continues to persist as one of the most heinous and prevalent issues in the world. The Department will benefit from this grant by providing education for teenaged females that will result in the reduction of female involvement in gangs through gang intervention, prevention of sexual harassment, identifying, preventing, and reporting domestic violence, prevention of teen pregnancy, non-submission to peer pressure, and anti-bullying education.

The conference will be held annually for three years starting in February 2014. The Los Angeles Police Foundation will be responsible for disbursement of all funds directly to all vendors approved to provide products and services via an agreed invoicing process. In addition, the funds will be used to compensate subject matter experts on teen issues, associated costs for supplies and training materials as well as lunch items for all participants. It must be noted that the "working lunch" aspect of this training is a vital component because it provides an opportunity for an additional hour of training in a casual, social setting.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.
