

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to waiving a one-year moratorium on cutting into newly resurfaced streets for a restaurant project.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin - Wesson):

- 1. APPROVE a waiver of the City's one-year moratorium on cutting into newly resurfaced streets to allow the construction of a gas line connection for the restaurant project located at 5656 West Manchester Avenue.
- 2. REQUIRE the permittee to properly repair and resurface the cut area, in accordance with Bureau of Engineering requirements, to maximize the longevity of the street.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## SUMMARY

At its meeting of April 7, 2014, the Budget and Finance Committee considered a Motion (Bonin -Wesson) relative to waiving a one-year moratorium on cutting into newly resurfaced streets for a restaurant project. According to the Motion, the restaurant project is in need of a gas line connection that requires construction in the roadway. Unfortunately, the corner location of this restaurant requires a street cut on Bellanca Avenue, which was recently resurfaced by the Bureau of Street Services between Manchester Avenue and Arbor Vitae Street. The City's oneyear moratorium on cutting into newly-resurfaced streets will delay the completion of this project. During Committee discussion, a representative of the Bureau of Street Services responded to related questions from Committee members. Committee members raised several issues which were to be resolved prior to full Council consideration. After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Budget and Finance Committee recommended to approve the Motion recommendations and forward this matter to the Council for its consideration.
