Summary:

On March 18, 2014, your Committee considered a March 7, 2014 communication from the Mayor relative to the BOE's request for Civil Service exemption for one position of Deputy City Engineer. According to the Mayor, the Deputy City Engineer oversees the BOE's Engineering Services Program. The position is responsible for directing technical specialty officers in Environmental Affairs, Geotechnical Engineering, Structural Engineering, and Real Estate who provide engineering services for other BOE programs and to other city departments' projects. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
