

**ORDINANCE NO. 185753**

An ordinance amending Los Angeles Administrative Code Sections 4.245.1 and 4.321, pertaining to vacation benefits for non-represented executive and manager positions, and general manager positions, respectively, to include the newly established classification of Executive Director Cannabis Department (Code 9429).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 4.245.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to add in proper alphabetical order the following classification:

<u>Code</u>	<u>Class Title</u>
9429	Executive Director Cannabis Department

Sec. 2. Section 4.321 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to add in proper alphabetical order the following classification:

<u>Class Title</u>	<u>Class Code</u>
Executive Director Cannabis Department	9429

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be operative upon publication, pursuant to Charter Section 252(g)

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


