An ordinance amending Subsection (b) of Section 4.127.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, pertaining to allowances for leave because of family deaths, to delete obsolete language.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 4.127.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended by deleting the following ultimate sentence:

By extending to an employee the specific benefits defined by this subsection, the City does not intend to confer or to imply any other unspecified benefits to such employee, or to the employee's domestic partner, or to the employee's household member, or to any other person.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be operative upon publication pursuant to Charter Section 252(g).

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
