

ORDINANCE NO. 182981

An ordinance amending Section 4.203 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, pertaining to voluntary payroll deductions, to limit future voluntary payroll deductions to recognized employee organizations with memoranda of understanding with City employee bargaining units and nonprofit umbrella charitable organizations approved by the Police Department.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Division (2) of Subsection (a) of Section 4.203 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read:


(2) other organizations approved by the City Council prior to April 1, 2014 for voluntary payroll deduction status under this section, that have a minimum membership of 250 active or retired City employees with at least 100 active or retired City employees maintaining enrollment in payroll dues deduction; and

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be operative upon publication, pursuant to Charter Section 252(g).


Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
