

Brief Summary: Notwithstanding an anonymous online petition recently initiated in certain Westside neighborhoods in the "Lower CD5 Area", the GWNC reaffirms that all of its neighborhoods strongly desire to be fully included in the provisions of the proposed ICO on mansionsization.

Additional Information: One the numerous "areas" designated for inclusion in the pending ICO is the "Lower CD5 Area. Unnamed individuals have started an online petition for to reconsider inclusion of Kentwood and MarVista/East Venice but erroneously implicate the entirety of the "Lower CD5 Area" neighborhoods in their petition language.



## NOTICE OF BOARD RESOLUTION

March 13, 2015

We, Owen Smith and Jeffry Carpenter, declare that we are the President and Secretary respectively of the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council and that on March 11, 2015, a Brown Act noticed meeting was held by the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council with a quorum of 15 board members present and that, by a vote of 15 yes to 0 no, and 0 abstentions, the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council adopted the following resolution:

WHEREAS an unsigned, anonymous online petition has begun circulating, advocating that various neighborhoods in Council District 5 named in the pending Interim Control Ordinance on mansionization be not included in the ordinance provisions going forward, and

WHEREAS, the anonymous petitioner alleges that there has been "little to no public outreach on this proposed ordinance in our neighborhoods", and


WHEREAS, there has been very intensive outreach and engagement of the affected single-family neighborhoods in the LaBrea-Hancock and Citrus Square areas of the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council in Council Districts 4 and 5, and

WHEREAS, direct, in-person petitions, circulated by concerned neighbors in all of these affected neighborhoods has resulted in overwhelming support for the imposition of Interim Control Ordinance protections pending satisfactory revision of the Baseline Mansionization Ordinance,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council reaffirms its strong support for adoption of Interim Control Ordinance protections within our borders and urges the City Council to proceed with swift adoption of an ordinance.
