Re: Carthay Square Historic Preservation Overlay Zone

Dear Members of the Los Angeles City Council,

At its regular meeting on March 11, 2015, the Board of the P.I.C.O. Neighborhood Council passed the following motion:

MOTION 2015.03.11.6C: The Board of P.I.C.O. Neighborhood Council reaffirms that its long time support for the creation of Carthay Square's Historic Preservation Overlay Zone.

The Board of the P.I.C.O. Neighborhood Council has previously issued a statement of support for the creation of Carthay Square's Historic Preservation Overlay Zone and granted funds to facilitate the studies necessary for its creation. The Carthay Square Historic Preservation Overlay Zone is long overdue and should be created as soon as possible. We request that this critical issue be separated for the ongoing discussions of the Base Mansions Ordinance and Interim Control Ordinances, which are much more complex and seem to be delaying the process unnecessarily.
