

MOTION

The City was recently awarded \$150,000 grant from the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) as part of the Net Toll Revenue Re-Investment Grant Program for marketing and safety activities related to the My Figueroa Streetscape Project. The marketing and safety activities were a direct request of the stakeholders that participated in the Mayor's My Figueroa Summit.

On June 3, 2014, the Council authorized the Department of Transportation, or the lead City Department, to execute any necessary funding and contractual documents relative to grant funds provided to the City under the Net Toll Revenue Re-Investment Grant Program (C.F. 14-0661). Although the Department of City Planning (DCP) was identified in the grant application as the lead City Department that is managing the My Figueroa Marketing and Safety Campaign, the Council action did not specifically authorize DCP to execute the funding agreement.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council authorize the Department of City Planning (DCP) to negotiate and execute an Agreement between the City and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to accept \$150,000 in grant funds as part of the Net Toll Revenue Re-Investment Grant Program for a three-year period for marketing and safety activities related to the My Figueroa Streetscape Project, subject to approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Controller be authorized to establish a grant receivable account of \$150,000 and a like amount appropriation account, entitled "My Figueroa Safety and Marketing Campaign," within the City Planning Grant Trust Fund No. 46Y-68, for reimbursement and disbursement of the above described grant funds.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of City Planning and/or the City Administrative Officer be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to these instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
