Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would allow the Board of Airport Commissioners to authorize its Executive Director to use the competitive sealed proposal selection process and the Construction Manager at Risk alternative project delivery method for select airfield capital improvement projects consistent with City Charter Sections 371 and 375.

The selected airfield capital improvement projects are as follows: Runway 7R-25L Rehabilitation, Runway 6R-24L Safety Area (RSA) and Rehabilitation, Runway 6L-24R Safety Area (RSA) and Rehabilitation, West Remain Over Night (RON) Aircraft Parking Improvements, and Secured Area Access Posts and Vehicle Checkpoints.

These projects are highly specialized and regulated making it critically important that the contractors have the expertise and experience to perform the projects in an accurate and timely manner. The effect of the enclosed draft ordinance, if adopted,

would enable Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) to most effectively meet the latest federal design and safety standards and enhance airfield operations and safety.
