At the regularly scheduled PPCC Board meeting on November 18, 2021, after review and discussion, the PPCC Board unanimously passed a motion to support CF 14-1057-S9 (Buscaino).

We believe that the proposed ordinance is a reasonable and necessary measure which allows the City of Los Angeles “to better regulate vehicle dwelling to prevent an over-concentration in any single community and ensure those living in their vehicles are connected to services and are input into the Coordinated Entry System - the first step on the path to housing.”
