Comments for Public Posting: The Mayor and Council must reinstate 85.02, immediately. Rundown RVs have consistently been parked in front of residential buildings, ignoring the weekly street sweeping signs and facing zero repercussions. We had one that was parked in front of our building, blocking sunlight into my home, for nearly 2 months and now another one has taken it's place for the past 2 months. We've even had a semi truck (without its trailer) parked in front of our building for weeks on end, in the past couple of years. I've reached out to LADOT, only to have them state "that vehicle has already been reported as abandoned" and yet they take no action. Additionally, as this is a residential area, along with a dry cleaner and two restaurants, whose businesses' visibility has been repeatedly blocked by these unsightly, and oversized vehicles, Oversize Parking Restriction signs should be hung, post haste, along the street front 800 & 808 Washington Blvd, in the 90292 zip code. These signs exist further west on Washington, where no residences exist, and appear to have been fairly effective.
