William Kil has been an attorney in private practice since 1986, specializing in business, corporate, civil litigation and real estate transactions. He received his J.D. degree from the University of Colorado School of Law and a B.A. degree from Pomona College. He is a member of the California and Colorado Bars.

He is a California licensed real estate broker who actively manages a private real estate investment company in Los Angeles.

In June, 2004, Mr. Kil was appointed by President George W. Bush to the President's Advisory Commission on Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders. The purpose of that commission is to increase economic opportunities and improve the quality of life through increased participation in federal programs for fifteen million Asian-Americans and Pacific Islanders living in the U.S. In May of 2006, Mr. Kil was appointed by Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa to the Los Angeles Police Department's Police Permit Review Panel, which is responsible for issuing and overseeing an array of permits for various types of businesses in the City of Los Angeles, and was reappointed to that commission by Mayor Eric Garcetti in 2014. He has served as the panel's chair and currently as vice chair.

His other community services include serving as Chairperson of the Foundation for Korean Language and Culture in USA, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose mission is to establish Korean language classes to promote Korean as a second language in American public schools for over 18 years, and he was awarded the Order of Civil Merit, Seongnyu Medal, by President Moon Jae In in 2017 for his meritorious services. Mr. Kil is also an active member of the Los Angeles Community Grassroots Advisory Board of the U.S. Army where his oldest daughter, Captain Alyson Kil, MD, currently serves as medical doctor, and the National Unification Advisory Council, Los Angeles Chapter since 1993; he has been appointed to the Council by six different presidents of the Republic of Korea as well as serving in various Korean American community and civic organizations.

He has successfully completed the FBI, LAPD, and LA County Sheriff's citizen academies to support law enforcement agencies and promote community safety and better relations between the law enforcement agencies and the local community.

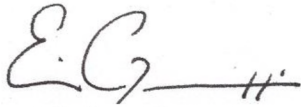
