PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2015 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant award.

Recommendations for Council action. SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the 2014-15 STEP grant in the amount of \$3,750,000 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety for the period October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.
 - b. Execute the 2014-15 STEP Grant Agreement on behalf of the City and submit all necessary documents relative to the grant award and to negotiate, execute, and submit any other necessary agreements and documents relative to the grant, subject to the approval of the City as to form and legality.

2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:

- a. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in the Police Department Grant Trust Fund No. 339/70.
- b. Spend up to the grant amount of \$3,750,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

- a. Establish a grant receivable in Fund 339 in the amount of \$3,750,000 and establish an appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund 339/70 for the receipt and disbursement of grant funds.
- b. Increase appropriations on an as-needed basis, as follows:

4. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. Approval of the above recommendations will allow for the expenditure of the 2014-15 STEP grant award totaling \$3,750,000. This action is in compliance with City financial policies in that grant funds are sufficient to support the grant activities. There are no matching funds required.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to Council dated December 5, 2014 (attached to the Council file), the CAO states that LAPD seeks retroactive approval to apply for and accept the FY 2014-15 STEP grant award in the amount of \$3.75 million grant award from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety for the period October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2015. On August 19, 2014, the Board of Police Commissioners approved LAPD's request. The CAO concurs with this action.

The CAO reports that the primary goal of STEP is to use enforcement and innovative strategies to reduce the number of fatalities and injuries in traffic collisions. LAPD will focus its efforts on Driving Under the Influence (DUI) enforcement and prevention; distracted driving; motorcycle safety, and primary collision factor enforcement (speed, bicycle, pedestrian and right-of-way violations). Enforcement operations and strategies will include multi-agency DUI task force operations, suspended driver enforcement operations, DUI saturation patrols, and red light and speed enforcement operations.

At its meeting held December 12, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to apply for and accept the STEP grant award, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners and the CAO, as amended to incorporate a technical correction of CAO recommendation No. 3b, as reflected above.
